Kelly Ott, Ergonomic Consultant with the Ohio BWC Division of Safety and Hygiene will present Working remotely or from home? How to reduce exposure to ergonomic risk factors.

Ergonomic hazards include working in awkward or uncomfortable postures and using excessive force or high repetition to complete a task. Working remotely

has created a need for good ergonomics when working from home. Good ergonomics ensure comfort and safety, enhanced productivity, all while keeping you healthy and pain-free.

Kelly Ott works to assist employers with developing a system-based approach to ergonomics and safety through services such as safety grant application assistance, ergonomic team development, safety culture assessment, and strategic planning.

Over the years, Kelly has directed the implementation of safety, environmental, and health programs focused on preventing injuries, improving communications, identifying risk factors, and training personnel.

Chambers of commerce interested in competing for the award first must qualify by participating in a vigorous multi-stage process. Organizations entering the



Chamber of the Year competition must meet minimum thresholds in at least three of five key performance areas, including net revenue and assets, membership account retention, and membership dollar retention.

"This national recognition for our Chamber is an incredible honor. On behalf of the Board of Directors, a huge thank you to Samira and her team for their tremendous efforts, the loyal support of the Chamber members, and the community for their involvement. It is an award that is well deserved as evidenced by the programs, projects and visionary ideas the Chamber team puts forth for its members and the community," said 2021 board chair Susan Marlar.

Chambers compete based on meeting key performance criteria on the ACCE Annual Operations Survey. Qualifying chambers enter the competition with a written application addressing all aspects of organizational operation and programmatic work. Applications are scored by peer chamber executives to determine finalists. Winners are selected from among finalists based on an interview before a panel of experienced chamber professionals.

"As a member of the Wooster Area Chamber of Commerce, we are so proud of the hard work and commitment Samira and her staff has shown for the betterment of our chamber membership. To hold the title of THE NATIONAL CHAMBER OF THE YEAR is such a great accomplishment. The award is well deserved and such an honor," said board chair elect Chad
